Range and Match News

As mentioned last month, a motion was approved at the August club meeting to budget \$4,200.00 for the 2006 Arkansas State Smallbore Rifle Silhouette Championship. This motion was confirmed by a second vote at the September club meeting. The match was held on September 16-17, and we hope to report on the results in the next issue of the newsletter.

In other news, the storage unit that was recently approved by the members has been installed near range #5.

Also, a motion was approved to place six temporary target boards on the bench rest range. We will install three 2x8 boards at 50 yards and three 2x8 boards at 100 yards.

Finally, a proposal was made to hire a maintenance firm to clean our range on a monthly basis, at a cost of approximately \$1,000.00 per month. No vote was held on this proposal; it was merely brought up for discussion and future consideration.

2007 Club Dues Vote Scheduled

Every year at the September club meeting we discuss the club dues for next year, opening the floor for suggestions. This year, two motions were made: one to raise the dues to \$75.00, and another to keep the dues at \$60.00. Both of these motions will be voted on at the October club meeting.

2007 Club Officer Nominations

President Paul Stiedle opened the floor at the September club meeting for nominations for officers for 2007. A motion was made and passed to nominate the current club officers to server again in 2007. No other motions or nominations were made.

Deer Hunter Open House

The club members have approved a motion by James Squires to hold an open house sight-in day for deer hunters. The open house will be held October 7 from 8:00 a.m. to noon.

Please Observe All Range Rules

Someone has been using high-powered rifles on lower range 2. This range is for **smallbore rifles only**. Anyone observed violating the club range and safety rules is subject to dismissal from the club. New members, make sure that you know what type of firearm may be used on each range. If you don't know, read your bylaws.

We'd like to remind club members not to move target stands closer to the sheds or pads. All target stands must be placed directly in front of a designated berm or backstop. Failure to comply with this rule, or any other range rule, may result in revocation of your membership.

Also, if you decide to burn trash in the barrels on the range, please check first to make sure a state, county or local burn ban is not in effect.
