## Range and Match News

A Match Directors dinner will be held in October, to set the schedule for the 2009 matches. If you are interested in being a match director, please contact the club president, Paul Stiedle.

In other news, Paul reported that there had been an incident at the range involving someone handling a firearm while another club member was downrange setting targets. A motion was made to put up additional safety signs on all ranges, but the motion was tabled pending clarification of the wording on the signs and the number of signs needed.

Also, related to range safety, club member George Toney reported that he has formed a committee for range 1. They met on September 7, and among other things discussed establishment of a safety flag system for range 1. George and his wife Twilla have donated a red flag for use on the range. When the flag is flying it means that a shooter may be downrange setting targets.

Finally, George Toney made motions to shoot the half-scale smallbore silhouette matches on November 8 and December 13 at 10:00 a.m., and to shoot the smallbore rifle silhouette matches on October 19, November 16 and December 21 at 1:00 p.m. as club matches, at a cost of \$3.00 for members and \$5.00 for non-members. The motions were seconded and passed.

## 2009 Renewals

The 2009 membership renewals are being sent out at a rate of 30 per day. All renewal notices should be mailed by October 10. Seniors age 65 and over are entitled to a 20% discount.

Please remember that if you do not renew before the February meeting you will be considered a new member and will be required to pay the \$100 range maintenance fee.

If you're a new NRA member be sure to include a copy of your NRA membership card or the address label from your NRA magazine with your club renewal form. This is required to confirm your membership in the NRA. If you don't include this information, your club renewal form will be returned.

## **Please Observe All Range Rules**

Anyone observed violating the club range and safety rules is subject to dismissal from the club. New members, make sure that you know what type of firearm may be used on each range. If you don't know, read your bylaws.

Shotgun shooters on the shotgun range (range 7) should use #4 shot or smaller. Shotgun slugs and shot larger than #4 are absolutely against the rules on this range, but may be used on all other ranges with the exception of the silhouette range (range 2).

Someone has caused severe damage to some of the target board posts on the plinking range. Hidden, motion-sensitive security cameras have been installed to

find out who is doing this. James Squires once again asks that shooters PLEASE stop shooting at the posts. If you need a practice target, contact James and he'll get you one.

We'd also like to remind club members not to move target stands closer to the sheds or pads. All target stands must be placed directly in front of a designated berm or backstop. Failure to comply with this rule, or any other range rule, may result in revocation of your membership.

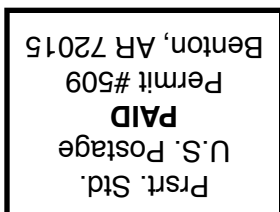
## **New Members**
