New Secretary/Treasurer Elected

At the March meeting we accepted nominations to fill the vacant Secretary/Treasurer's position. Cheryl Craig the only nominee and was elected unanimously. Glad to have you aboard, Cheryl!

Along with our new officer, we have a new club information line. The new number is 501-602-2228.

Range and Match News

George Craig made a motion at the March meeting to install a security light (known as a "night watcher") on the range, if First Electric will run the power line for free. The monthly cost of the light would be around \$35.00. The motion passed, but this will require a separate notification mailing to all club members before it can be voted on at a future club meeting.

Also, a motion was made to purchase two motion target stands (they hold paper or cardboard targets) for use in IDPA and three-gun matches. The total cost is \$450.00 (\$200.00 each plus \$50.00 for shipping). The motion was seconded and passed.

Political Candidates Invited

A motion was made, seconded and passed at the March meeting to invite political candidates to come to our meetings, share their views, and entertain questions from the members. Two candidates were present at the meeting and spoke to the club after the motion was approved: Jeremy Hutchinson, who is running for State Senate in District 22, and Colonel Conrad Reynolds, who is running for the U. S. Senate.

John Arellanes, who made this motion, sent us the following additional information:

"After the May 18, 2010 primary elections, the Benton Gun Club will host a monthly non-partisan format for the candidates in the General Election to introduce themselves and have a question and answer period. Invitations will begin with the June 14, 2010 meeting and end with the October 11, 2010 meeting. Due to time constraints, there will be only four scheduled speakers per meeting and each candidate will have approximately ten minutes.

"The following candidate positions will be extended an invitation: Governor, Lieutenant Governor, U.S. Senator, U.S. Congressional Districts, Secretary of State, and Commissioner of State Lands. This list represents eighteen potential speakers. We will extend invitations to as many of the State Senators and State Representatives as possible that represent the members of Benton Gun Club in their districts in the event the above candidates do not respond.

"The invitations will be extended after the Primary Election and reservations of the available dates for speakers will be on a first-come/first-served basis. Club members are encouraged to attend these meetings and participate in the exchange of ideas and free speech."

NRA/ILA Donation Motion

The club gets a small commission from each NRA membership and renewal that is handled through the club. Each year we entertain a motion to donate these commissions to the NRA/ILA. The commission amount this year is \$2,800.00. The motion to make the donation was made, seconded and passed at last month's meeting, and was confirmed by a follow-up vote at the March club meeting.

Five-Year Planning Committee Meeting Held

The five-year strategic planning committee held its second meeting on March 1. Ideas brought up for discussion included putting in underlayment and gravel to help with the mud and installing an electronic gate system (but this one is too expensive for serious consideration at this time). They also discussed requiring club members to keep their membership IDs visible at all times, for security purposes, and looked at a request to improve the skeet facilities. None of these are being put forth as motions yet, they're just being discussed and considered. We also want to hear from you. We are looking for a person (or persons) to plan and coordinate youth-focused shooting and training activities for the club. If you would like to volunteer, please contact one of the club officers.

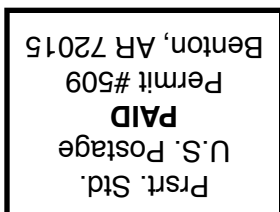
New Members
